Dear Section Chief Hardy,

This follows my prior letter to you of February 20, 2011.

Thank you for producing a small number of records (122 pages) in response to my FOIPA request of 12/1/2009, most of which (77 pages) is a portion of the FBI manual.

The purpose of this letter is to meet and confer with you about that fact that the production is inadequate.

You state in your responsive letter that the request includes serials 4-6 of my applicant file, plus "miscellaneous documents" from the San Francisco field office. It appears all you did in the search was send an Electronic Communication to the Applicant Recruiting Unit at San Francisco for any documents filed since your previous FOIPA production of September 2009. It appears no effort was made to search for responsive documents to request nos. 4, 5, 6, 7 (TURK), 9, 17, 18, 21, 22, 25, 26, 27, 29, 30, or 33. I note that your response provides no indication of how many records were located but not reviewed.

Most of the missing documents could be located using the table provided in my prior letter of February 20, 2011. All of the documents in question would be discoverable in a civil lawsuit against the Department of Justice. Please reprocess the request and provide the requested documents within thirty days or I will have no choice but to file a FOIPA lawsuit.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
