This is to advise you of the status of your application for a position with the FBI.

As a result, we must rescind our Conditional Appointment Offer. In making this decision, we conducted an objective assessment of the information available to us and the needs of our organization. The choice between the many qualified candidates is a difficult one, and I regret that we are unable to offer you a more favorable decision.

Our action to rescind your Conditional Appointment Offer does not constitute a security denial. On future security applications and forms you may affirm, insofar as it relates to this action, you were not denied a security clearance.

You may request specific information from your file under the provisions of the Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) by submitting a written request. Should you decide to submit a request, you should include your full name, date and place of birth, and present address. You must verify your ~~identity with a notarized signature, or in lieu of the notarized~~ signature, a declaration pursuant to Title 28, U.S. Code, Section 1746.
