Your letters, dated November 21, 2009, and November 30, 2009, to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), were forwarded to the Initial Processing Unit (IPU), Internal Investigations Section (IIS), Inspection Division (INSD), FBI, for review. The IIS/INSD is the FBI entity responsible for investigating allegations of serious misconduct or criminal activity on the part of FBI employees.

In your letters, you advised that you applied for a position with the FBI and that you were defamed. It is alleged that Special Agent Grahm L. Coder, prepared the FD-302 with false and misleading information. You alleged the FD-302 falsely attributes statements to you that you never made. You also alleged that Analyst Abby M. Halle stated that your work performance was affected by alcohol. However, you stated in your SF-86 that your work attendance was affected, not your performance.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the IPU/INSD has reviewed your allegations and has determined that there is no evidence of misconduct on the part of any FBI employee. Therefore, no further action will be taken by this office.
