Subject: Request for Notice of Appellate Procedure

Dear Division Chief,

Applicant respectfully references his pending FOIPA requests of 7/23/2009, 8/20/2009, 9/7/2009, 9/20/2009, and 10/21/2009, pending FOIPA appeals of 9/9/2009 and 9/20/2009, letters to Acting Unit Chief Montchell Brice of 9/16/2009 and 9/23/2009, and letters to the current Unit Chief dated 10/20/2009 and 11/21/2009.

Applicant advises being denied information on how to appeal a negative suitability determination made by SACU on 6/30/2009. Not a single FOIPA request or letter from Applicant has been responded to except for a 7/6/2009 FOIPA request for the applicant file. The suitability determination and supporting FD-302 were suppressed from Applicant by way of artful FOIPA deletions until Applicant filed an action with the Merit Systems Protection Board.

Applicant seeks information from the Division Chief, as Applicant understands the Division Chief is SACU's superior command. Applicant apologizes if the Division Chief is not the appropriate recipient, but the Manual of Administrative Operations and Procedures was suppressed from Applicant under FOIPA, requiring Applicant to review a similar treatise, the Naval Correspondence Manual, for similar authority.

Applicant encloses a CD-ROM containing the complete MSPB filings of Applicant and the Administrative Judge, as well as prior correspondence. Applicant requests notice and an opportunity to be heard regarding the false and misleading FD-302



that caused Applicant's disqualification from government service due to a new Special Agent's fabrication of information and concealment of information from the FBI.
