The next phase of processing includes a structured interview and writing exercise (Phase II). Please note that there are thousands of applicants at this particular stage of processing, and only those candidates determined to be most competitive, based on standardized selection criteria and the investigative needs of the Bureau, are nominated for the limited number of Phase II testing vacancies.

Your qualifications and competitiveness in the Special Agent Selection System (SASS) will be consistently monitored, and you will be contacted in the event that you are selected for further processing. Under the current SASS, your Phase I test scores will remain on record indefinitely and you will not be required to retest.
