Dear Unit Chief Bungo,

This concerns a verified 137-page complaint that I filed on December 13, 2010 with OIG regarding misconduct at the FBI. I sent the complaint to the Investigations Division of OIG pursuant to the instructions on its website.

I later called OIG on 2/16/2011, and I was advised that OIG forwarded my complaint to your office.

I emailed you on 2/10/2011 and 2/16/2011 to ask about status. No substantive response was forthcoming. Although you advised on 2/16/2011 that you could certainly check on the status of my complaint, you have not advised me of its status.

The complaint I filed alleges nine counts of misconduct against five employees of the FBI for their falsification of investigative records and other criminal or dishonest acts. The complaint is supported with documentary evidence from the FBI's own files. The complaint raises important issues implicating the FBI's "core values," especially that of Integrity. Further, the complaint shows violations of the Merit System and the FBI's own policies by a component of the FBI's Security Division. In addition, the complaint exposes failures in the FBI's system of discipline, including deficiencies that were supposed to have been rectified years ago after the famous Bell report on the FBI's Office of Professional Responsibility.

The complaint raises important issues that I believe my elected representatives will be interested in. Naturally I would hope to avoid that route. When you have a moment, could you please let me know where we stand?
