Dear Officer Rodriguez Hernandez,

I am a lawyer in Redwood City. I was formerly in a dating relationship with Mahsa Parviz in May 2021 before ending the relationship just before she was arrested in the indicated case. I later learned that Ms. Parviz is an impostor who was lying to me the whole time about various matters, and I had followed her criminal case to see what happened.

I'm writing because it surprised me to learn that Ms. Parviz claims to reside in the Bay Area in a recent Domestic Violence petition that she filed against me in state court (see attached cover page). The DVRO case is a repeat of a dismissed 2023 case that she filed while in prison. Her sole goal with these fraudulent proceedings has been to pressure me into removing my Hall of Shame web page about her, which is part public service announcement and part retribution for her diabolical, illegal schemes.

Ms. Parviz is using two addresses I have previously seen her use, which I believe are not valid. One is the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco, and the other is a \$8 million house in Atherton that probably belongs to a different former boyfriend. I thought this was against the terms of her release requiring supervision in the Central District.

In any case, I would like to let you know that Ms. Parviz is again misusing the court system for another scheme, and I am suffering because the TRO requires me to turn in all my guns and my CCW permit during the case. This matter is a complete and total fabrication, and Ms. Parviz is clearly insane, which causes me concern for public safety, as well. I hope there is some way you can address this with Ms. Parviz for the benefit of her current and future victims.
